

CHILDREN'S CAMP MATERIALS CHECKLIST

_____ Mead Hard-Bound Composition Notebook, labeled with your child's name (Returning students should bring last year's notebook)

_____ Smock for art class (an oversized t-shirt works well)

Pencil Case (labeled and which should contain the following)

_____ Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils

_____ Children's Scissors

_____ Pens or Pencils

_____ Glue Stick

Lunch Box (labeled and which should contain the following)

**** Please do not pack peanut butter, Nutella or peanut or nut products. We often have students who are severely allergic.**

_____ Lunch

_____ Lunch Beverage

_____ Ice Pack to keep lunch cold

Please pack your child a full lunch. We will be providing two Italian snacks per day. The snacks will be given at about 10:30 am and 2 pm.

Please note: Refrigeration is NOT available. Microwave is NOT available.

Water Bottle

_____ Large Water Bottle, labeled (to use throughout the day due to the very warm weather)

Toy

_____ Please have your child bring a small toy for our "minimercato" ("mini" supermarket) to the first day of camp. The children will exchange these toys with other children in the camp. Please label the toy with your child's name on masking tape.

You may supply a new toy (inexpensive, around \$3.00 or so) or a clean, presentable, "used" toy that is in EXCELLENT condition. (One that your child is willing to give up.)

◆ Please label ALL items to ensure their return. *Grazie!*

◆ Each day, only lunchbox, water bottle and notebook go home (Notebook goes home to review with parents!)

◆ Due to the size of the "cubbies," large backpacks are not allowed.
