Discussion

- 1. Isaiah opened the discussion by introducing Cynthia Cusimano to the Committee; Jo Ellen mentioned that in response to the survey and suggestions received through Suggestion Box, Cynthia will update the committee about on-going training, workshop, and professional development certificate program opportunities for staff members of the College. The professional development certificate program consists of three tracks, each of which build competencies specific to existing roles within the College. The program also serves as a supplemental resource to help prepare staff members for potential future opportunities at the College. It was pointed out that having completed and received a certificate does not necessarily mean a 'promotion' but rather a career growth and development. - 2. Pop Up Pub will be restarted through campus departments twice a semester. Host department will be in charge of creating a theme and ordering hospitality food with a set budget from the SWLC. - 3. The SWLC hosted S'mores and Hot Cocoa at the Pavilion last January 18, 2019 with approximately 40 attendees.
- 4. Suggestion for Spring semester events are: 1) I-phone photo contest: by identifying places around Nazareth campus, and 2) Baby picture contest: the winner will be the person who can identify the most.
- 5. Updates:
 - 1. Campaign for United Way will be last week of February and first week of March.
 - 2. From Suggestion Box: Parking issue at Nazareth Campus was discussed.
 - 3. The Weight Watcher Program: The program did not meet the required paid memberships and was discontinued; however members still meet without a leader.
 - 4. Succession plan for May 2019: Laura Putnam has agreed to be the next chair. The Committee will seek nominations in March with an election in April. To stagger the vacancy, an incoming member will be assigned as vice-chair.
