Turin

Friday, January 17th – Sunday, January 19th (INCLUDED in Nazareth Program Fee)

Turin, the first Capital of Italy, is a vibrant city with a beautiful balance between its historic past and modern present. It is home to many museums rated among the best in Italy. The trip includes transportation, hotel, museum visits, optional walking tours, and a dinner.



Bologna ArteFiera

Friday, January 24th (INCLUDED in Nazareth Program Fee)

Visit Bologna's ArteFiera, where some of the world's most important art from a wide variety of galleries is all exhibited under one roof. The fair is divided into sections of contemporary and modern work. For more info : www.artefiera.it



San Gimignano

Friday, February 7th (INCLUDED in Nazareth Program Fee)

Explore this medieval hill-top town of San Gimignano, set in the province of Siena. Wander the narrow streets with its numerous towers and famous Vernaccia white wine. Nestled inside of this historical treasure you will also find one of Italy's premiere contemporary art galleries, Galleria Continua.



Montepulciano

Friday, February 14th (INCLUDED in Nazareth Program Fee)

This field trip is an exclusive tour among the ages: visit Montepulciano, from its Etruscan origins, passing from the Middle Ages, to its "pearl of the Renaissance" monuments, churches and streets!



Rome

Saturday, March 28th – Sunday, March 29th (INCLUDED in Nazareth Program)
No visit to Italy is complete without a trip to Rome, where a great historical landmark can be found around every corner. Learn first-hand why "Rome wasn't built in a day." This trip includes the Roma Pass (museums and public transport network) along with guided walking tours.



Pompeii and the Naples Bay

Friday, April 3rd – Sunday, April 5th (INCLUDED in Nazareth Program Fee)

Explore the ruins of ancient Pompeii and take advantage of free time allowing side visits to nearby Capri. Includes round-trip transportation, hotel in Sorrento, optional guided visit of Pompeii, and an exclusive just for SRISA archeological workshop in the Naples San Gennaro catacombs with its director.



Giogalto Villa

Friday, April 17th (INCLUDED in Nazareth Program Fee)

Visit director Rebecca Olsen's country home, Giogalto, in the Casentino Valley where there will be cooking lessons followed by an authentic Tuscan lunch. See why the Tuscan countryside is renowned worldwide for its beauty while relaxing in this private villa. Make sure to bring a camera and sketchbook!
