

ENTRANCE COUNSELING AND MASTER PROMISSORY NOTE (MPN) INSTRUCTIONS

Federal Direct Loan regulations require students to complete Federal Direct Loan Entrance Counseling and Loan Agreement (Master Promissory Note [MPN]) prior to loan disbursement. Entrance counseling and MPN may be completed at studentaid.gov.

STEP 1: Visit studentaid.gov.

STEP 2: Under the In School tab, select Complete Loan Entrance Counseling.

- Log in using the **student** federal FSA ID.
- **STEP 3:** Click START to begin Entrance Counseling.
 - Under Select School to Notify, choose NY and add Nazareth College.
 - Select I am completing entrance counseling to receive Direct Loans as an undergraduate student.
 - Answer all questions and submit entrance counseling.
 - o Tip: When asked to ADD LOAN, enter **Direct Unsubsidized** and **\$27,000** (four-year estimate). Actual loan type/amounts are disclosed on the financial aid offer.
- STEP 4: Under Next Steps, click Complete a Master Promissory Note.
 - Click START next to MPN for Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loans.

o This MPN is for all undergraduate and graduate students borrowing direct subsidized and unsubsidized loans.
