College search + planning tips

Fall

- Plan to **attend an info session and Nazareth University campus tour:** naz.edu/visit
- Taking the SAT/ACT?** Nazareth is test optional, so the SAT/ACT is *not required*. However, if you do plan to take the exam, check with your guidance counselor and plan accordingly.
- Connect with your regional Nazareth admissions counselor** to be sure you are kept up to date with deadlines and procedures: naz.edu/counselors
- Find out if your application requires an **audition or portfolio review** (music, dance, theatre, art), then schedule yours early and use our tips to prepare: naz.edu/auditions
- Determine** if you are submitting Early Decision applications.
- Submit FAFSA** by required deadline.
- Complete at least one application** by Thanksgiving.

Nazareth Early Decision Deadline: **November 1**

Fall-Winter

- Finish and submit your application.**
- Have your high school send a transcript** to the colleges you applied to online.
- Ask your guidance counselor** to send a midsemester grade report.
- Act on the result** of any Early Decision applications.

Nazareth Early Action Deadline: **December 1**

Nazareth Regular Decision Deadline: **February 1**

Spring

- Watch your mail** for notifications.
- Visit Nazareth University** in bloom and notify your guidance counselor of your choice.
- Send your deposit** by May 1.
- Prepare** for and take any standardized tests like AP exams.

Nazareth Deposit Deadline: **May 1**

Deadlines

Early Decision: November 1

Early Action: December 1

Receive an early response to your application, but you do not have to commit until the normal reply date of May 1.

Regular Decision: February 1

Universal Deposit: May 1

FAFSA: June 30
