



Acknowledgement of Nazareth University Protection of Minors Requirements

Non-Nazareth entities utilizing university facilities to host events or activities that include minors must conduct themselves appropriately in the presence of minors, be aware of Nazareth’s Protection of Minors Policy and their obligation to follow the policy, and agree to abide by the Conduct Requirements listed below.

Conduct Requirements

Minor abuse and inappropriate conduct, including but not limited to the following, is prohibited:

- Engaging in any form of physical or emotional abuse of a minor
- Engaging in sexually inappropriate conduct of any kind toward or in the presence of a minor, including but not limited to:
 - Sexual abuse of a minor
 - Touching a minor in an inappropriate or illegal manner
 - Making pornography or other sexually inappropriate materials in any form available to a minor or assisting a minor in gaining access to such materials
- Neglecting the duty of care for a minor under the adult’s supervision, including but not limited to:
 - Failing to protect minor’s health and safety (e.g., exposure to unreasonable risk of injury or extreme weather)
 - Failing to ensure the use of appropriate protective equipment (e.g., in laboratory or athletic participation)
 - Failing to meet minor’s basic needs
 - Leaving minors consistently unsupervised
 - Using inappropriate language in the presence of minors
- Engaging in the use of alcohol or illegal drugs, or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs during programs or activities for minors
- Enabling, facilitating, or failing to appropriately address a minor’s use of alcohol or illegal/non-prescribed drugs
- Contacting a minor through electronic media, including social media, for the purpose of engaging in any prohibited conduct, including sexual conduct
- Offering or making a gift to a minor for the purpose of engaging in any prohibited conduct, including sexual conduct
- Participating in a sleepover under the auspices of the program or activity, unless (1) one of the minor’s parents or legal guardians is present or (2) one of minor’s parents or legal guardians has provided written consent and there is at least one other adult, and the two adults remain in each other’s presence at all times
- Engaging in one-on-one contact with a minor unless authorized by the responsible Nazareth Official for the University-sponsored program
- Picking up or dropping off minors from their homes (except the driver’s child or children) before, during, or after the program or activity
- Releasing a minor from a University-sponsored program without a written authorization from the minor’s parent or guardian

Obligation to Report

- Inappropriate conduct must be reported in accordance with Nazareth’s Protection of Minors Policy.
- Individuals who witness or receive a report of minor abuse, or who reasonably believe such abuse has occurred must report the abuse to Campus Safety (585-389-2850) immediately.
