## Library



### Jennifer Burr

Preparing for the launch of Nazareth Digital Collections, built on an institutional repository product from Ubiquity. To date, I have created brief metadata records for 267 publications of Nazareth faculty and staff. These items have been identified through CASE display records and Academic Affairs reports. Ilka Datig (Head of Instruction and Outreach) provided a pre-print of one of her published articles as our first full text item.

Deborah Janetos (College Archivist), Heather Lagoy (Systems Librarian) and I met with St. John Fisher University Library colleagues to learn from their experience managing Fisher's institutional repository.

Completed an inventory of the Rare Book Room's main collection of 1539 items, focusing on provenance, condition, and scarcity.

Conducted further research on a subset of 225 items identified as scarce through the Greenglass process. The initial list was compiled by library colleagues; my role was to confirm and add details regarding issues ranging from problematic OCLC record matches to transcription errors. I also researched each item, and added background information as available, such as publishing history and provenance.

Relocated to my office from the Rare Book Room: Five shelves of books donated in the 1920s by Msgr. Joseph W. Hendrick (or possibly from his estate), along with a file box of correspondence from his brother, Thomas Augustine, first American bishop of Cebu, the Philippines, microfilm reels of the correspondence, and its calendar and index. This created needed space in the Rare Book Room and offered the opportunity to document information about how (or why) these items came to Nazareth.

Discovered a letter in a book in the Rare Book Room that evidently is an original letter handwritten by Charles Dickens. This has been verified by sharing a scan by email with Sean Grass, Professor of English at RIT and president of the Dickens Society and Leon Litvack, Principal Editor, the Charles Dickens Letters Project. Dr. Greg Foran provided the contacts.

Ongoing: At the request of Jody Barker, I am trying to track down the current copyright holder of Merton-related audio cassettes held in the Merton Room. The purpose of this project is to obtain permission to transfer the content to a more current, accessible format.

According to LibAnswers data, I responded to 231 questions (or 'transactions'). 145 came from faculty; 68 were from staff. 182 questions (or 78.8%) were received by email; 40 (or 17.3%) were in-person. 87% of the questions were related to acquisitions and/or collection management.
