

SPARK Grant Application Checklist

Step 1: Determine Eligibility and Experience

- You are a first-time undergraduate student
- You have been enrolled at Nazareth for fewer than 24 months **OR** you are a **transfer student** and have been enrolled at Nazareth for fewer than 12 months
- Your GPA is at least 2.5 (if you are unsure, check your grades on [NazNet](#))
- You are enrolled at Nazareth for the semester following your SPARK experience
- You have met with your Career Coach and have an approved resume
- You are **not** receiving other Nazareth College funding for this experience
- You have completed your FAFSA for the upcoming year, if applicable, and submitted all documents to the Financial Aid Office

Step 2: Complete Application Materials

All SPARK Opportunities:

- Complete Career Coach approved resume
- Obtain unofficial transcript through [Student Planning](#)

If you are using SPARK for an internship:

- Apply for and secure an internship for the summer
- Submit internship and SPARK application before the registration deadline for summer
- Complete Internship Supervisor Approval Form
- Complete Faculty Advisor Approval Form (For 3-credit major-specific internships ONLY – must be a rising Junior)
- Answer Career Competency Questions in complete paragraphs
- Complete the [Student Payment Check Request Form](#)
- Set up your [E-Check Account](#) (Even if you have an on campus job).

If you are using SPARK for Study Abroad:

- Determine Study Abroad Experience and check with Josh Fess to ensure SPARK eligibility
- Complete International Experience Approval Form
- Discuss with Josh regarding the distribution of your funds.

If you are using SPARK for Research:

- Secure Nazareth Faculty Research Mentor
- Develop or apply for and secure research experience
- Complete SPARK Grant Research Application and App
- Complete the [Student Payment Check Request Form](#)
- Set up your [E-Check Account](#) (Even if you have an on campus job).

Step 3: Submit Application

- Complete SPARK application (independently or with your Career Coach)
- Inform your Career Coach that SPARK application is complete (**VERY** important)

Step 4: After You Are Approved For SPARK

For internships:

- Look for internship course registration information from Dale Leyburn
- Register for internship course using permission code received from Dale
- Pay internship course registration fee

For Study Abroad:

- If your study abroad program is credit-bearing through Nazareth, please register for the corresponding course
- Pay study abroad course registration fee (only for Nazareth credit-bearing programs during the summer)

For research:

- Look for research course registration information from Dr. Megan Tobin
- Register for research course using permission code received from Dr. Megan Tobin
- Pay research course registration fee
- (The spring following your research experience) present research at Creativity Activity and Research Showcase (CARS)
