### Spring Class Schedule Go Live

This is two weeks earlier than in the past, allowing more time for advising meetings and for students to carefully make plans for the next term.

### Registration Timing

After a successful registration period for fall semester and very positive feedback, the timing for spring registration will open up for graduate students over a 2 day period and undergraduate students over a 4 day period. Each undergraduate year level will have one day of registration priority in order to provide consistency, transparency and equity.
