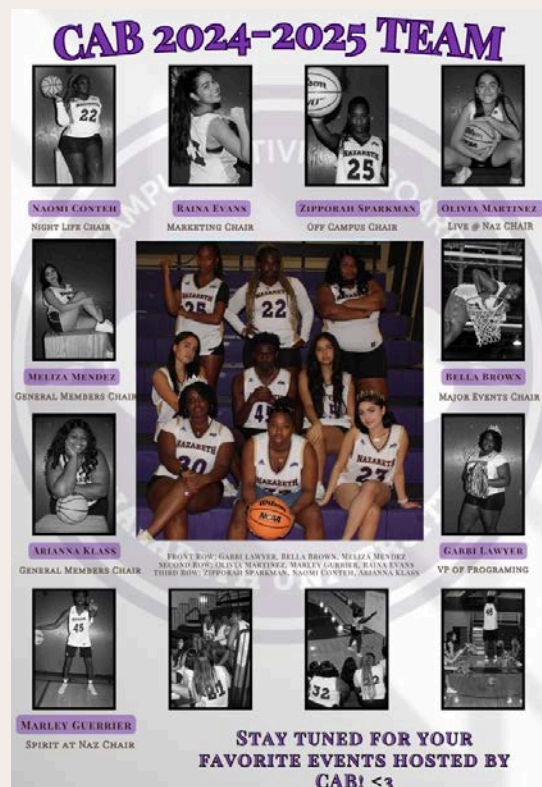
**Gabbie Lawyerr:**

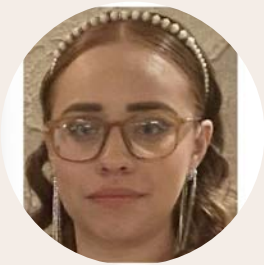

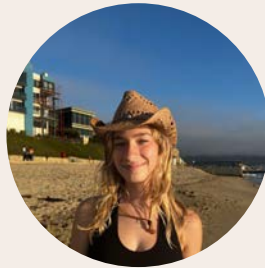

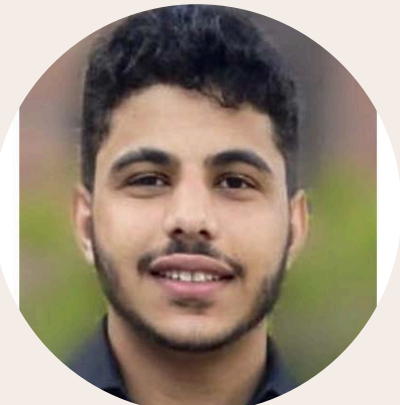
