Nomination Process:

Criteria: Must be a faculty or staff member at Nazareth and current advisor of a recognized student club or organization.

Review Committee: The review committee will be composed of representatives from Student Experience and the Undergraduate Association.

Review Process: The awardee will be notified by March 31st and will be honored at the Teaching Excellence – Student Success Awards Ceremony on April 9, 2026.
