

Addendum: Releasing Graded Student Submissions

1. Each P@N assignment is linked to an assessment instrument, or rubric. Once students submit their artifact/file, it is sent to the instructor for assessment. There are three options for releasing assessment results to students:

- **Results Available Immediately:** results available immediately.
- **Never:** results will never be made available.
- **Held Until Released:** results will be held, until the assessor manually releases them.
