- Demonstration of taken or scheduled to take for ALST, EAS and at least one of the CST exams certification exams
- Submission of EdTPA by April 1st
- Two letters of recommendation: one from cooperating teacher or student teaching supervisor; one from a faculty member
- Demonstration of scholarship and practice
- Commitment to full-time graduate study
- Commitment to working in public schools two full days a week

Important Information:

Students who apply to this program commit to full-time graduate study with two days a week commitment to work in public schools. Accepted students will be expected to participate in the Summer Session I through enrollment in two graduate program courses and attendance in orientations for the program. In addition it is expected that students will enroll in 12 graduate credit hours during both fall and spring semesters. *Students will receive a six credit graduate assistantship during both the fall and spring semesters.* Students will complete the program by the end of Summer Session II. The Teaching Fellows Program is a full year commitment. Any deviation from this commitment may result in the Fellow needing to refund the college for the graduate assistantship monies. Students need to maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 with grades of B- or above in all courses, and demonstrate successful performance in public school settings. A portion of the students' courses will be completed in a hybrid format. Each student will select a preference for a three course (9 credits) concentration listed on the following page. The application process is highly competitive. Please note if you are applying to an Additional or Changing Level Program you will be required to complete a seven-week practicum experiences.
