Sample Behavior Descriptors

- 1. Begins class on time and previews lecture/discussion content
- 2. Clearly states the goal and objectives for the class session
- 3. Class activities (e.g., lecture, lab, group work) proceed in a logical fashion
- 4. Class activites support goals and objectives
- 5. Clearly organizes and carefully explains assignments
- 6. Incorporates and effectively utilizes different types of instructional media and teaching/learning approaches as appropriate
- 7. Presentation is appropriately paced with adequate volume and eye contact
- 8. Engenders enthusiasm for the subject matter
- 9. Responds to changes in student attentiveness
- 10. Use of humor is positive and appropriate
- 11. Able to correlate, synthesize, and summarize important ideas/concepts
- 12. Presents information at an appropriate level
- 13. Emphasizes major points with relevant examples
- 14. Presents challenging questions to stimulate discussion
- 15. Puts students at ease when asking questions or seeking guidance
- 16. Encourages students' questions, involvement, and debate
- 17. Listens carefully to student comments and questions
- 18. Responds constructively to student opinions, comments, and questions
- 19. Respects and encourages a diversity of opinions
