The Nazareth Summer Research Program for High School Students

- Runs July 2–August 3, 2018
- 20 hours per week
- Participating students will earn a \$1,200 stipend

High school science students are invited to apply to a five-week interdisciplinary research program in biology, chemistry, and environmental science.

Students will conduct hands-on research overseen by faculty members and experienced undergraduate researchers. This project involves sampling, detection, analysis, and bioremediation of pollutants in area soils and waterways. The program involves both field work and laboratory work.

Eligibility:

- Open to students entering grades 10, 11, and 12 in Fall 2018.
- Students must provide their own transportation to and from Nazareth College.

Applications must include:

- A completed application (found at naz.edu/dept/chemistry).
- A 300- to 500-word essay addressing your interest in and suitability for the program.
- Two letters of recommendation from high school faculty members submitted by the faculty member directly to dgiache1@naz.edu.
