FALL

- Go to fall open house events.** Campuses come to life during the fall with classes in full swing, athletic games, performances, activities, and more. See it for yourself during a tour or open house. Go to naz.edu/visit to sign up.
- College fairs + high school visits.** Find out if the colleges you are interested in will be visiting your high school this fall or will be at college fairs near you. If so, connect with them to get answers to your questions about majors, how to apply, financial aid, and more.
- Connect with admissions counselors** from your top pick colleges to be sure you are kept up to date with admissions deadlines and procedures.
- At collegeboard.org, find the dates for **upcoming SAT exams, subjects tests, and AP exams**. Schedule and sign up for your exams.

WINTER

- Research program-specific admission requirements** to be sure you have time to pursue and complete requirements before submitting your application. For example, visual and performing arts programs often require auditions or portfolio reviews for which you will need to prepare in advance. Admission to some health care programs requires documented volunteer service hours. Knowing these extra requirements ahead of time will ensure that you have time to complete them.
- Organize your info.** Use a file box or accordion folder to store and organize college brochures, financial aid info, and other helpful documents for quick reference.

- Apply for summer job or internship.
- Next year's class schedule.** As you select classes and plan your schedule for next school year, consider your goals for career and college and plan your class selections to align with your end goals.

SUMMER

- Hit the road!** Schedule visits and tours to your top pick colleges.
- Write a first draft of your **application essays**.
- Applying early decision?** Find out when your top picks deadlines are for early decision applications, mark your calendar, and begin working on your application. Often, these deadlines fall earlier in the fall of your senior year.
