2021-22 TEACH Grant Application

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program provides grants to undergraduate and graduate students who intend to teach. In exchange for the grant, the student agrees to serve as a highly qualified full-time teacher in a ***designated high-need subject area*** in an elementary school, secondary school, or educational service agency that serves students from ***low-income*** families for at least four complete academic years within eight years after completing (or ceasing enrollment in) the course of study for which you received the grant. If the student does not satisfy the service obligation, the TEACH Grant will be treated as a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan with accrued interest.

- _____ I have completed the 2021-22 TEACH Grant initial/subsequent counseling ***AND*** 2021-22 TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATS): <https://studentaid.gov/teach-grant-program>
- _____ I understand that the grant is intended only for students who plan to become teachers in a high-need subject field and plan to teach in low-income schools as determined by the federal government or state which is subject to change.
- _____ I understand that if I am unable to meet the conditions outlined in the Agreement to Serve, the TEACH Grant will convert to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of the original disbursement.

- 1) Bilingual education and English Language Acquisition
- 2) Foreign Language
- 3) Mathematics
- 4) Reading Specialist
- 5) Science
- 6) Special Education

NOTE: It is important to understand that in order to fulfill the TEACH Grant service agreement, the primary responsibility of your teaching position must be in one of the designated high need fields listed in the above box. Many of the Nazareth degree programs listed are TEACH Grant eligible based solely on the special education component. For example, an individual whose position is the special education teacher would be fulfilling the high need component, however, an individual whose primary position is the elementary teacher or history teacher would NOT be fulfilling the required service agreement in a high need field.
