College search + planning tips



FALL

- PSAT plans?** Find out the date for this year's PSAT exam, typically in October. Sign up and begin preparing.
- Explore career options.** Job shadow a friend or family member for a day.

Take advantage of career exploration opportunities at school (field trips, guest speakers, etc.).

Do some research online, investigating career opportunities and the level of education required, average salaries, and projected growth in the industry.
- College matchmaker tools.** Explore online tools for matching your interests and goals with colleges that might be a good fit for you.

WINTER

- List and score:** Make a list of the top criteria that your perfect college must have, considering things like size, how close to home, selections for majors and minors, career preparation and outcomes, athletics, study abroad, and other special qualities.

Assign a score, from one to ten, for each criteria (for example, if it has a strong athletics program, a score of 8 or 9; if it has limited athletic options, a score of 2 or 3, etc.). Total your numbers to reach the final score for each college.
- Mail management.** College brochures and communications can give you a better perspective on the type of education each college offers—and whether or not it's the right fit for you. Sort through them as they arrive in your mailbox, filing your top picks for those colleges that meet your criteria. A file box or accordion folder works nicely for this.

SPRING

- Investigate your top college picks.** Visit college websites; talk to your teachers, counselor, family, and friends; and begin to learn more about options for majors, scholarships, internships, athletics, career outcomes, and other special qualities of each college on your top picks list.
- Next year's class schedule.** As you select classes and plan your schedule for next school year, consider your goals for career and college and plan your class selections to align with your end goals.

SUMMER

- Get a summer job** — save for college!
- Hit the road!** Schedule visits and tours to the colleges nearest to you.
- Schedule your SATs + Exams.** At collegeboard.org, find the dates for upcoming SAT exams, subjects tests, and AP exams. Schedule and sign up for your exams.
